#### Submitted by Michelle Milam Ken Taylor's Corn Casserole


- 2 16oz cans Cream Corn

#### October has been a really tough month!

With two hurricanes, there has been damage, but we have been blessed that no one lost their home, and no one was hurt. We are working on cleaning up the community and getting things fixed. As reported, other areas in Lakeland and across the state endured significant damage. Resources and supplies have been delivered to the more devastated areas, so we ask for patience as we get the fence and other damages repaired. Lakeland Electric will pick up 8 bags of yard debris per pick up. They are requesting that it be separated and bagged. Polk County and FEMA will be picking up the large tree debris and branches. We do not have a timeline of when the yard debris will be picked up at this time.
