FOXWOOD VILLAGE has a **Lending Library**, fully stocked by resident donations, for use by residents. It is maintained by Cindy Drafta, Nancy Spranger & Christine Brinkman, with assistance from Susie Beuscher & Erin Robb. Available is a large assortment of fiction, non-fiction & reference books, both hard covers & paperbacks . The desk often has note pads and/or calendars available; please help yourself to them. There are also Magazines of various interests available for reading, as well. The closet has shelves stocked with puzzles & games. Mostly all of the books, games & puzzles are donated & gently used. Near the door, is a rack of assorted greeting cards (birthday, get well, thank you, holiday etc.) available for your lastminute use, free of charge. The Library is furnished with tables (2) & chairs, should you prefer to read or play a game, in place.

Most recently, Cindy started a Children's Basket, at her own expense, with books & games, for those residents who have visiting grandchildren, to enjoy & share.
