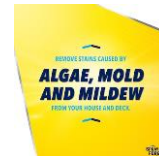
MESSAGE FROM THE PARK MANAGER

Please be aware that the city of Lakeland has us under phase 3 water restrictions, which limits watering to specific days.

Unfortunately, pressure washing is prohibited unless it is being done before painting. If you have mold or just a dirty house, there is a product that will make the home look pressure-washed without using water. It is "Spray Forget." It comes with a hand sprayer, so you don't have to attach it to a hose. You just spray it and walk away, no rinsing. The only downfall is that it only works on the non-covered areas of the home. So, it does not work under the carport.



We are approaching that time when our friends who travel back north will be leaving us. I want to remind them that the outside items need to be put away so that any storms that arise don't blow them away. Also, there should be no plastic sheds outside of the carport. They are not approved and will become missiles in a storm.
