At our July 28th coffee hour, **Danielle Green, the Community Liaison from the Lakeland Police Dept.** came in for her monthly visit. She distributed the “Neighborhood Insider” newsletter and read the list of Police activities or events that happened in our community during the previous month. One of the big topics was SCAMS.

Notes from Park Management – Shane Hartness

- Our grounds keepers are changing out the foliage.
- The park office is being remodeled.
- A new Gate service company will be here to work out the current problems occurring when the gate is left open.
- Please do not remove and gardening or construction material you see laying around. It will be used in time.
- In anticipation of any storms, please remove anything from around your house and in the carport that can “fly away” in the wind.
- The pavement seal coating at the club house entrance will be resurfaced. When we get the date and time, you will see notices around the park and in the club house conference room.

Friendship Scams

Scammers create fake online identities to build trust through social media and lately text messages on your phone.

- Be cautious of strangers who contact you unexpectedly
 - Don’t send money or invest. If an online relationship quickly turns into a request for money, it’s almost certainly a scam.

Digital Arrest Scams

Criminals are posing as police officers and federal agents to convince victims they are under criminal investigation.

- Threats for immediate arrest over the phone. *Hang up immediately.*
- Fake arrest warrants or court documents sent by text, email or social media. (Senior citizens are sometimes contacted that they missed jury duty.)
- Fake phone numbers to call if you question their validity.
- Pressure to pay fines to avoid jail.

Remember:

- Real court orders and arrest warrants are not served by phone calls, emails, text messages or social media.
- Never send money because someone threatens arrest. Ex: Request for payment by wire transfer, cryptocurrency, gift cards or payment apps like PayPal.
- If you’re unsure, contact the agency using a verified phone number – not the number that called you.

If you believe you’ve been targeted by this scam, report it to your local law enforcement agency and the FBI Internet Crime Complaint Center (IC3) at www.ic3.gov.
