WATER AEROBICS

As you may know, each morning (weather permitting), our residents meet at the pool at 9AM (9:30AM on Tuesdays). Water Aerobics has many benefits, and we would like to see more men and women participate.

Who knew? All these benefits just from a little water exercise!

- **Low impact**

The water's buoyancy reduces your body weight, so your joints don't have to bear as much pressure. This can be especially beneficial for people with arthritis or joint pain.

- **Increased flexibility**

The water's density creates resistance, which can help you move your joints and muscles in new ways and increase your overall flexibility.

- **Improved strength**

Water's viscosity also creates resistance, which can help you build muscle strength. Many classes also provide handheld weights to increase the resistance and activate more muscles.

- **Better cardio fitness**

Water aerobics can help strengthen your heart and lungs, which can improve your endurance and cardio fitness.

- **Reduced blood pressure**

Water aerobics can help strengthen your heart muscle, which can make it more efficient at pumping blood and lower your blood pressure.

- **Improved mood**

The water's soft, fluid nature can have a calming effect on your mind, which can help you feel more relaxed and improve your mood.

- **Reduced stress and anxiety**

Water aerobics can help you relieve stress and anxiety, which can help you feel more relaxed and improve your mood.

- **Better sleep**

Water aerobics can help you sleep better.

- **Reduced risk of disease**

Water aerobics, like other water-based exercises, can reduce your risk of developing diseases like heart disease, diabetes, and cancer.
